This book shows how accessible communication, and especially easy-to-understand languages, should be designed in order to become instruments of inclusion. It examines two well-established easy-to-understand varieties: Easy Language and Plain Language, and shows that they have complementary profiles with respect to four central qualities: comprehensibility, perceptibility, acceptability and stigmatisation potential. The book introduces Easy and Plain Language and provides an outline of their linguistic, sociological and legal profiles: What is the current legal framework of Easy and Plain Language? What do the texts look like? Who are the users? Which other groups are involved in the production and use of Easy and Plain Language offers? Which qualities are a hazard to acceptability and, thus, enhance their stigmatisation potential? The book also proposes another easy-to-understand variety: Easy Language Plus. This variety balances the four qualities and is modelled in the present book. For many of us, thinking about the future conjures up images of Cormac McCarthy's *The Road*: a post-apocalyptic dystopia stripped of nature. Richard Louv, author of the landmark bestseller *Last Child in the Woods*, urges us to change our vision of the future, suggesting that if we reconceive environmentalism and sustainability, they will evolve into a larger movement that will touch every part of society. This New Nature Movement taps into the restorative powers of the natural world to boost mental acuity and creativity; promote health and wellness; build smarter and more sustainable businesses, communities, and economies; and ultimately strengthen human bonds. Supported by groundbreaking research, anecdotal evidence, and compelling personal stories, Louv offers renewed optimism while challenging us to rethink the way we live. At the turn of the century and the beginning of the new Millennium, India has made extraordinary industrial and economic progress. At the same time the sub-continent is faced with innumerable problems in the area of basic social services. Religion plays an important role in the interpersonal relationship and social interaction of the people. Religion is not only worship and prayer, but dictates such factors as who could come in physical contact with the other and who has the right to draw water from a well and who is deprived of it. Because of these factors it is necessary to look at the perception of disability in the soteriologies of India. This study confines itself to Hinduism as the major religion of India, that is based on the achievement of salvation and thus to escape the cycle of birth-, death- and rebirth and Christianity, on the other hand, that is involved in trying to improve the conditions of the poor and the needy and its main precept is the love of neighbours. It would be interesting to pursue these distinctions in reviewing the perception of disability in both these religions. Includes entries for maps and atlases. Subjective human rights of children are reasonably fathomed cooperatively by practice, activism and research. Approaches in interdisciplinary learning and teaching in childhood and children's rights are demonstrated as possibilities for social change through acquiring competencies to think and act children's rights. This book is dedicated to Manfred Liebel and focuses on his life's work. He has, throughout his life and work, combined social scientific childhood theories and children's rights discourses with practical, topical examples of protagonism and agency of children and young people in different national and international contexts. *Cell Synchrony: Studies in Biosynthetic Regulation* focuses on the processes, principles, applications, methodologies, and approaches involved in biosynthetic regulation, including chromosome replication, cellular biosynthesis, and enzyme synthesis. The selection first takes a look at the theory of synchronous cultures, synchronous replication of the chromosome in *Bacillus subtilis*, and chromosome replication in *Escherichia coli*. Discussions focus on attempts to characterize the physical state of replicating DNA, cell division and the regulation of chromosome replication, regulation of sequential chromosome synthesis, synchrony of chromosome replication, and determination of the cell doubling-time distribution function from the decay of synchronization. The text then examines nuclear events in synchronously dividing yeast cultures, periodic enzyme synthesis in synchronous cultures of yeast, and light-induced synchronous sporulation of a myxomycete. Topics include periodicity of enzyme synthesis, use of synchronous cultures for studying cellular biosynthesis, and cytological observations on synchronously dividing cultures. The book explores the effects of temperature on the mitotic cycle of normal and synchronized mammalian cells; behavior of sulfhydryl groups in synchronous division; and morphogenetic and macromolecular aspects of synchronized *Tetrahymena*. The selection is highly recommended for researchers interested in biosynthetic regulation. Kaum ein anderes Thema bewegt seit Jahren die öffentliche und fachwissenschaftliche Diskussion gleichermaßen und polarisiert dabei so stark wie die 'Grüne Gentechnik'. Die um ihren Nutzen und Schaden entbrannten Debatten erfassen verschiedene wissenschaftliche Fachdisziplinen, die Politik, Verbraucher- und Umweltschutzorganisationen, die Kirche und die Medien ebenso, wie sie die Bevölkerung mit ihren Vorstellungen über die Beschaffenheit der Natur und der Lebensmittelerzeugung betreffen. Dabei haben sich die Fronten zwischen Befürwortern und Gegnern der Grünen Gentechnik über die Jahre verhärtet, und es ist ein ideologischer Streit entbrannt, der auch vor der Wissenschaft nicht Halt gemacht hat. Die Auseinandersetzungen und auch die Berichterstattung sind vorwiegend geprägt von undifferenzierten Betrachtungen und einer emotionalen Aufladung des Themas. Für die Bevölkerung stellt sich vor allem die Frage, wem man überhaupt glauben oder vertrauen kann. In diesem Spannungsfeld gibt Manuel Thiels Buch einen wertvollen Überblick über die Vielseitigkeit und Komplexität des Themas Grüne Gentechnik, liefert Fakten für ein besseres Verständnis des Themas und schärft gleichzeitig den Blick dafür, dass eine ernsthafte, differenzierte Auseinandersetzung keinesfalls in simplen Schwarz-Weiß-Kategorien enden kann. Nicht zuletzt durch die gründliche thematische Aufarbeitung hilft es auch jenseits des Fachpublikums dabei, sich im Spannungsfeld Grüner Gentechnik zu orientieren und Kontroversen besser zu verstehen. Insgesamt besticht das Buch vor allem durch seine systematische Strukturierung und klare, schnörkellose Darstellung. It is conceptualized to offer a variety of perspectives and views on the question of the future of the German-Jewish past. The volume addresses topics such as antisemitism, Holocaust memory, historiography, and political issues relating to the future relationship between Jews, Israel, and Germany. While the central focus of this volume is Germany, the implications go beyond the German-Jewish experience and relate to some of the broader challenges facing modern societies today. This collection represents the first historical survey focusing on the notion of consciousness. It approaches consciousness through its constitutive aspects, such as subjectivity, reflexivity, intentionality and selfhood. Covering discussions from ancient philosophy all the way to contemporary debates, the book enriches current systematic debates by uncovering historical roots of the notion of consciousness. In recent years, western societies have experienced a fundamental transformation in the way crime is understood and dealt with. Against the backdrop of a current great interest in narratives in criminology, this book draws on a narrative perspective to explore this transformation. Drawing on data from Germany, the book focuses on changing narratives of youth crime in recent decades and the exact narratives that have been used, abandoned, invented or criticized in order to instil particular understandings of crime and measures to act against it. The author draws upon a wide range of sources, including debates on youth crime in six parliaments from 1970 to 2012; articles on youth crime in four police and six social work journals from 1970 to 2009; and case studies with 15 young defendants who were interviewed before and after their trial and whose trial was observed. In doing so, the author reconstructs narratives over several decades and, overall, reveals a fascinating and multifaceted scope of narratives of youth crime. This book will be of great interest to students and scholars of youth crime and justice, as well as criminology, sociology, politics and social work more broadly.

A bibliography containing approximately 300 references on children and media violence published after 1970 completes the yearbook.
