Publisher Description Sleep Mechanisms This volume contains the proceedings of the conference "Colloque de Géométrie Symplectique et Physique Mathématique" which was held in Aix-en-Provence (France), June 11-15, 1990, in honor of Jean-Marie Souriau. The conference was one in the series of international meetings of the Séminaire Sud Rhodanien de Géométrie, an organization of geometers and mathematical physicists at the Universities of Avignon, Lyon, Marseille, and Montpellier. The scientific interests of Souriau, one of the founders of geometric quantization, range from classical mechanics (symplectic geometry) and quantization problems to general relativity and astrophysics. The themes of this conference cover "only" the first two of these four areas. However, these subjects are so interrelated that a classification by headings such as "pure differential geometry, applications of Lie groups, constrained systems in physics, etc.," would have produced a completely different clustering! The list of authors is not quite identical to the list of speakers at the conference. M. Karasev was invited but unable to attend; C. Itzykson and M. Vergne spoke on work which is represented here only by the title of Itzykson's talk (Surfaces triangulées et intégration matricielle) and a summary of Vergne's talk.
